# Requirements

You must have the [Divi Theme by Elegant Themes](#) installed to use this Child Theme.


An Elegant Themes Membership is required to download the Divi Theme. The Divi Theme is NOT included with this child theme.

Please note: the images in the demo have been replaced with placeholder images in the actual theme files.

Ensure you have the Divi Theme installed and activated prior to installing the Non-Profit Child Theme.

To avoid any issues during installation it is highly recommended that you use this child theme on a fresh installation of WordPress.

It is also a good idea for SEO purposes to navigate to Settings > Permalinks and set the 'Common Settings' to 'Post name'.



## Preparation

Step 1.

After purchase, download the '[unzipme\\_Non-Profit.zip](#)' file from your '[My Account](#)' page at <http://elegantmarketplace.com> or click the download link in your purchase confirmation email.

Step 2.


Unzip the '[unzipme\\_Non-Profit.zip](#)' file to your computer, it contains the following files:  
Non-Profit.zip (the Non-Profit child theme files)  
Non-Profit-demo-content.xml (the Non-Profit theme demo content)  
Non-Profit Divi Theme Options.json (the Non-Profit theme customisation settings)  
style.css (a backup of the Non-Profit style sheet)

## Theme Installation

Step 3.

In your Wordpress admin panel navigate to Appearance>Themes>Add New and click on '[Upload Theme](#)'. Locate the '[Non-Profit.zip](#)' file on your computer and then click '[Install Now](#)'.

When the install is complete click on '[Activate](#)', you will then see the Non-Profit Child Theme as the active theme in your theme panel.



# Plugin Installation


Step 4.

To install plugins you need to select Plugins from the wp-dashboard and click the 'Add New' button on the plugins page. Once you click 'Add New' it will take you to the plugin installation page, click 'Upload Plugin' button and choose plugin files provided in the Plugins folder one by one. Once all the plugins are installed and activated More to step 5.


# Import Settings & Demo Content

Step 5.


Next, navigate to Tools>Import in your admin panel and then click on 'Wordpress'.



Click on 'Choose File' and select the 'Non-Profit-demo-content.xml' file from your computer and then click 'Upload file and Import'.




Next, assign the posts to an existing user by selecting from the dropdown box, tick the option to 'Download and import file attachments' and click 'Submit'. Wait for the 'All done. Have Fun!' message.



To import the divi theme options go to **Divi > Theme Options** Click on the up and down arrow icon at the right top of theme options settings. It will give a pop up which, click on the import tab and choose file '**Non-Profit Divi Theme Options.json**' and click Import divi theme options button.

To import the divi theme customiser options go to **Divi > Theme Customiser** Click on the up and down arrow icon at the left top of the settings. It will give a pop up which, click on the import tab and choose file '**Non-Profit Divi Customizer Settings.json**' and click Import divi theme options button.


To import the divi library layouts go to **Divi > Divi Library** Click on the up and down arrow icon at the left top of the settings. It will give a pop up which, click on the import tab and choose file '**Non-Profit Divi Builder Layouts.json**' and click Import divi theme options button. Congratulations you have successfully installed the theme.

Step 6.



# Home Page Settings


Step 7.

Next navigate to Settings>Reading in your admin panel. Tick the option 'A static page' and select 'Home' from the Front page drop down box.




## Caldera Forms
